## Module 5: Cleaning equipment

This Module details the cleaning equipment required and the specifications for the equipment.

Brand or generic names are not provided as manufacturers of equipment may change over time.

Cleaning equipment must be maintained, used and stored or disposed of in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

Cleaning equipment must be stored in a designated area with access to hand hygiene facilities.

Ward and unit staff must have access to cleaning equipment during times when regular cleaning staff are not available.

Before commencing a cleaning task, staff must check that the selected equipment is in good working order and appropriate for the cleaning task as per the manufacturer's instructions and facility requirements.

On completion of the task, reusable cleaning equipment must be cleaned and stored as per the manufacturer's instructions, and disposable or single use cleaning equipment must be disposed of as per the manufacturer's instructions.

### Colour coding of reusable cleaning equipment

The following colour codes for reusable cleaning equipment are mandatory.

<i>Infectious/Isolation Areas</i>	<b>YELLOW</b>
<i>Toilets/Bathrooms/Dirty Utility Rooms</i>	<b>RED</b>
<i>Food Service and Food Preparation Areas</i>	<b>GREEN</b>
<i>General Cleaning</i>	<b>BLUE</b>
<i>Operating Theatres</i>	<b>WHITE</b>
