1. Accessing NSW Medicines Formulary reports

- 1. Open your internet browser and navigate to https://formulary.health.nsw.gov.au/
- 2. Click on **Reports** in the menu bar on the NSW Medicines Formulary home page.

Download NSW Medicines Formulary	 A 'last updated' date from November 2023 onwards indicates: the date a medicine formulation was added, or the date a major change was made to the listing (for example, restrictions, notes, brand names), or the date a listing was reviewed by the Secretariat, with no changes to the face up content within the online platform (a new 'Review Date' will also apply).
	A 'last updated date' prior to November 2023 represents updates made during the transition and adoption stage of the



	formulary. These dates will be updated when the medicine listing is due for review or when a change to the listing occurs.

2. The following functions can be performed within the report window:

a. Filter data

- i. Click on the **down arrow** to open the data available for a particular filter.
- ii. Use the **search** field to narrow down filter options.
- iii. Select on the data fields to be filtered. Use the Ctrl key to select multiple values.
- iv. Click on the **Clear selections** icon to clear the filter (appears on hover).
